 - Teacher Laptops
 - Working on getting these set up and imaged. Close to getting resolution and set up for distribution
 - Another survey to see if teachers want to order a laptop
 - Apple TV for teachers with laptop (used to project iPad/Mac Air on Projector)
 - Still improving user-friendliness and practical issues.
 - *Some* are still getting dropped connections
 - Concerns with AirPlay delay (most likely due to Wifi issues)
